### Minimum Expectations for all Pupils, Staff, Contractors and Essential Visitors to our Schools

Pickwick Academy Trust is committed to providing support to those families who require it during these unprecedented times. In order that we can continue to do this whilst keeping our staff and your children safe we would like to make you aware of the following minimum expectations when you enter the premises on one of our sites:

- Please do not come to the school office unless we are expecting you. Please contact the school by telephone first to discuss your concern.
- Please do not come to school if you or a member of your household display one of the known symptoms of Coronavirus – a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
- Please ensure that you follow the latest government advice on social distancing when on school premises and any additional individual school procedures, especially during break and lunch time and when dropping off and collecting children
- Please use hand sanitiser where available on entrance to the school site or if not available please wash your hands for at least 20 seconds using soap and water on arrival at school and regularly during your time on the premises, at least before and after eating and handling food; after using the toilet; after blowing your nose, sneezing or coughing; before and after giving or receiving first aid and before and after touching an animal, their food or their cages.
- Please wash your hands or use hand sanitiser where available when leaving the school premises
- Public Health guidance recommends washing your clothes regularly to reduce the spread of the virus.
