Thursday 4th April 2019

Friday 5th April 2019

Children can come dressed to school in Spring colours.

Egg Rolling

Children can bring in a named and plain (no decoration), hard-boiled chicken egg for our exciting egg rolling competition. Prizes are for eggs first across the line, which are as complete/intact as possible. There will be one prize per boy and girl in each class which, will be awarded for the egg which travels furthest without significant damage—no throwing! We had a couple of 'mis-splats' last year, so please make sure the eggs are very hard boiled!!

Please do not decorate or reinforce the egg.

Egg Decorating competition

This is an **optional activity**. Children can bring in a hard boiled, decorated egg. This can be decorated in any way they like. It could be made into a favourite character, linked to a hobby or any other creative ideas the children have. The children can use a range of materials e.g.– paint, collage, felt tip pens etc. There will be a prize for the most creative egg in each class.
